

BOARD VOTING

Votes on all motions and resolutions shall be by “yes” and “no” votes. No secret ballot shall be used.

In all meetings, the vote of each member must be publicly cast and recorded. Members shall vote individually, either by raising their hands or making a voice vote, and the votes of the members shall be individually recorded.

Each member and officer shall have one vote. All motions shall be carried by a majority of the members present and voting, provided a quorum is present, or as otherwise required by law. A majority shall mean “more than half” of the votes cast. Blanks or abstentions shall not be counted.
