## **Holdenville Athletics Event Guidelines**

Holdenville Public Schools are recommending the wearing of masks at school for students and staff so we will be applying the same for athletic events. We would like to welcome you to our facilities. As we navigate through these uncertainties during this COVID-19 Pandemic, we would like you to know the health and safety of all our student-athletes, coaches, staff, officials, administrators, parents and fans are our primary concern.

When you attend events in our facilities, we are asking you to follow the guidelines below:

- 1. Mask or face coverings are required for all participants, coaches, workers, officials, security, fans or anyone entering a HPS facility. We ask that all fans exercise social distancing procedures within HPS facilities.
- 2. Participants and coaches must wear masks when on the bench or sideline. (examples: dug out, BB bench)
- 3. While we believe sportsmanship is important, to the development of our youth, at this time, we will recommend no hand shaking between opposing teams, both before and after games, to reduce contact as much as possible.
- 4. At some of our venues, there may be areas marked off as unavailable. Please refrain from sitting in these areas to help us keep everyone safe. If necessary, HPS will determine the number of fans allowed in a facility or contest. Please check our website to see which of the events will be broadcasted.
- 5. For participants, officials and coaches: **NO** shared towels, clothing, shoes, water bottles or equipment.
- 6. Masks will be required in locker rooms, training rooms, coaches' offices and any area considered outside of the playing field or court. Masks or face coverings are also required in all HPS vehicles.
- 7. Only necessary personnel will be allowed in the press box or at the scorer's table. Parents and fans will not be allowed on the playing field or court after the contest is over.
- 8. All HPS athletes will have temperature taken daily when they enter our facilities. Temperatures must be under 100 degrees. WE expect the same from our opponents.
